ABC Prenatal Program

Target population: Pregnant women and teens with Medi-Cal

Geographic area: Fairfield and surrounding areas

Services: Provides prenatal care, CPSP wrap around services, substance abuse screening, education, and counseling for women at risk

Adolescent Family Life Program

Target population: Pregnant and parenting teens ages 18 and younger; can be 19 if pregnant and not yet graduated from high school

Geographic area: All of Solano County

Services: Provides case management, childbirth education, infant massage classes, and support groups

Black Infant Health

Target population: Pregnant African American women 18 and older

Geographic area: Vallejo, Fairfield, Suisun, Vacaville

Services: Provides case management and Social Support and Empowerment classes

Children's Nurturing Project

Target population: Pregnant and parenting teens, parents in recovery, children 0-2

Geographic area: All of Solano County

Services: Provides parenting classes for pregnant and parenting teens and parents with children 0-5 in recovery, Welcome Baby home visits and developmental screening for children 0-2

Additional information: With client consent, Planned Parenthood will refer all teens up to age 20 for parenting classes, all new babies will get a free gift with the Welcome Baby visit, clients can be referred to Welcome Baby at nine months of pregnancy

Target population: Pregnant women and teens with Medi-Cal

Services: Provides telephonic care coordination

Additional information: Clients receive \$100 incentives for attending all prenatal and postpartum care appointments, provides transportation to prenatal care appointments for high risk clients, provides breast pumps for Partnership HealthPlan women returning to work or school, client must call to participate

Prenatal Care Guidance

Target population: Pregnant women and teens

Services: Assists women into early prenatal care and medical insurance, reengages lost to follow up clients back into prenatal care, provides assessments and referrals for high risk pregnant and postpartum women and teens under age 20 (see criteria for assessments)

Public Health Nursing
